*** All of my classes listed below are designed so that it can be taken for several years without a repeat of artwork or project. We may revisit some lessons in order to reinforce past instruction or theory, but the lesson theme, concept and style will differ greatly. It is very common to have repeat students for several years in one class in order to receive the maximum knowledge and practice of skills.**

Intermediate Art (5th - 8th)

Students do not need prior art experience for this class. Students will learn the elements and principles of design, composition, color theory, vocabulary, 3-dimensional design, beginning drawing techniques and will use a wide variety of art material all integrated with art history. This course is teacher-designed following the National Visual Arts Standards.

Time is given at the end of the hour and a half class for cleaning up.

Many supplies are supplied by me. There are however, some student supplies that will need to be purchased and brought back and forth by the student.

High School Art (8th- 12th)

This class is great for the beginning high school artist or an experienced student who likes to use a wide variety of art products with a wide range of lessons. In class students will learn the elements and principles of design, composition, color theory, art vocabulary, 3-dimensional design, perspective, plus drawing and painting techniques with some professional supplies. Art history is incorporated within the lessons. This course is teacher-designed following the National Visual Arts Standards. Time is given at the end of the hour and a half class for cleaning up.

Many supplies are supplied by me. There are however, some student supplies that will need to be purchased and brought back and forth by the student.

Drawing (8th- 12th)

This class is great for the high school artist who has had at least 1 year of high school art or would like to have a more challenging experience in the area of drawing.

In class the student will learn:

1. Advanced drawing techniques; still life, line drawing, shading, composition and design, body and facial proportions, 1 and 2 point perspective
2. Advanced color theory and texture techniques.
3. How to use professional supplies such as Prismacolor Colored Pencils, charcoal, pen and ink, technical pencils and pastels.
4. Create artwork covering art styles and periods.
5. Critiquing

Art Supply List

Intermediate, High School, and Drawing Supply List

It is important for students to own these items so they may work on artwork at home. (Most of these supplies can be found at Michael's or Hobby Lobby.) Watch for Michaels 40% off on 1 product coupon (Michael's ad) in the newspaper for the more expensive items. Also, look on line for online 40% off coupons at Hobby Lobby and Michaels. If you like to purchase things on line, DickBlick.com has great rates! ***Don't forget to use a sharpie to label all items with your child's initials.**

*Strathmore **Drawing** Pad (**not sketch pad**) or similar type (11x 14) Weight of paper must be over 60 lbs.

*Magic Rub vinyl eraser (may come with Graphite Drawing Kit)

*Pencil Sharpener (may come with Graphite Drawing Kit)

*Any container to hold supplies.

Prismacolor 48 Colored Pencil Set (we will not need this right away) These pencils are somewhat expensive, but they are superior and these pencils can be purchased individually if one particular color runs out or if you would like to add to your basic colors.

Kimberly Graphite Drawing Kit #25 (comes with sharpener and vinyl eraser)
(Staedtler set of 12 is also a nice, superior brand found at Office Depot)

General's Charcoal Pencil Set (**High School and Drawing only**)

Design brand kneaded eraser (for working with charcoal pencils) (**High School and Drawing Class only**) sometimes it comes with the charcoal kit like above.
